**In order to standardize the portfolios of Jaguar Battalion Cadets your portfolio binder will be organized and assembled as follows:**

All cadets will use the 3 inch, 3 ring binder provided by JHHS JROTC. You will need a maximum of 12 dividers. They may be commercial or you make design and make your own.

2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Year Cadets, during their tenure in JROTC will maintain and expand their portfolios from year to year by adding work completed from any subject area within or outside of the JROTC program. You should be able to take your cadet portfolio with you to any interview and showcase your accomplishments and experience.
