- Enforce and execute Co CDR's directives, standards, and guidance
- Train and develop subordinate cadets for promotion
- Maintain unit physical accountability
- Maintain effective communication with Co CDR, PSG's, SL's other 1GS's, and CSM
- Coordinate with Co CDR, other 1SG's, CSM, PSG's
- Keep cadets informed
